- Ministers have mandated responsibility over issues performed by the NVWA to the Inspector-General













General Food Law



Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002



General Food Law is the <u>foundation</u> of the food safety legislation:

"Food/feed shall not be placed on the market if it is unsafe"

(unsafe = injurious to health or unfit for consumption)

Scope

- production, processing & distribution of food & feed
- excludes private domestic activities

General objectives

- high level of protection of human life and health
- protection of consumers interests (fair practice)
- free movement in the Community of food & feed
- based on: international standards, risk analysis



General Food Law



Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002



Main **responsibilities food business operators** (FBOs):

- Responsible for importing, producing or selling safe food/feed, that comply with the legislation.
- Traceability of product: 1 step forward and 1 step backwards.
- Obligation to notify the authorities in case unsafe food/feed has been placed on the market and take corrective actions (withdrawal/recall of unsafe products).

Main **responsibilities member states** (MS):

- Enforce, monitor & verify FBO official controls, surveillance, communication
- ✓ lay down effective, proportionate & dissuasive measures & penalties upon infringement.


Model for risk-based inspection planning

- In the past only based on non-compliance but <u>limited resources</u> and <u>EU requirement</u>
- Model Implemented in April 2022
- Model based on Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) among others
- 4 groups of risk factors:
 - Inherent Risk Factors
 - Mitigation Factors
 - Compliance Factors
 - Time Factor (since last inspection)
- Risk profile determined by adding/subtracting points
- Linked to our planning tool

Stimulating compliance

- <u>Compliance assistance</u> webinars, NVWA website, comprehensive guides (additives, food supplements, labelling,....)
- Private certification schemes (ketenborging.nl):
 - Stimulate participation of FBOs
 - Investigate possible use in supervision and controls ... More responsibility where it belongs
 - Investigate options for data exchange between these schemes and NVWA.
- <u>Transparancy</u>: Stimulate compliance by publication and disclosure of inspection results (audits, inspections, sampling and analyses). <u>Long term goal</u>:
 All inspections results publicly available on the website



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
